Letter to the Archbishop Requesting Confirmation

Once you have decided to be confirmed in the Church, it is time to formally request the sacrament from the Archbishop. Your letter to the Archbishop should be neatly written or typed and should clearly express:

- That receiving the sacrament is your personal decision
- Why you want to be confirmed
- That you have prepared for the sacrament through instruction, study and prayer
- A description of the service you did for others
- The name of your sponsor and why you chose him/her
- How you intend to live and practice your faith more fully in the future

The letters will be given to Sr. Christian who will deliver them to the Archbishop.
