Letter to the Archbishop Requesting Confirmation

Once you have decided that you want to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, it is time to formally request the Sacrament from the Archbishop. Your letter to the Archbishop must be **typed** and should clearly express:

- That receiving the sacrament is your personal decision
- Why you want to be confirmed
- That you have prepared for the sacrament through instruction, study, and prayer
- A description of the service you did for others
- The name of your sponsor and why you chose him/her
- How you intend to live and practice your faith more fully in the future

The letters MUST be DELIVERED to your teacher (Mr. Blase/Fr. Philipp/Mrs. Helfry) who will deliver them to the Archbishop. The letter should be typed and printed out; do not email it. Please, do not put the letter in an envelope. You must sign the letter with your name.

DO NOT MAIL YOUR LETTER TO THE ARCHBISHOP Sample Letter – Write the ideas in your own words.
